


Setting a Price X Line Alert

A Price X Line alert notifies you when a bar crosses above or below a pointer tool value.

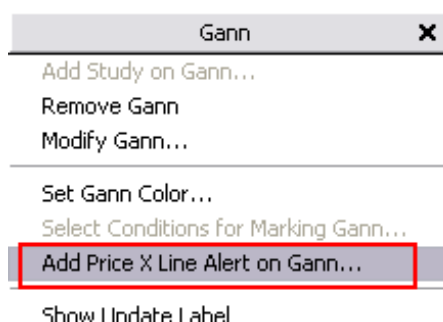
The last price represents the last price of the instrument, not the last trend value.

The above and below trigger prices are the same. They appear automatically and represent the last pointer tool value.

If the pointer tool value is above the current price, the above price column will be active, and the below price column, which is the same as the above column price, will be grayed out or inactive. Conversely, if the pointer tool value is below the current price, the below price column will be active, and the above price column will be dimmed or inactive.

The above alert will trigger if the current price crosses above the pointer tool value. Likewise, the below alert will trigger if the current price crosses below the pointer tool value.

1. Right-click a pointer tool on a chart.
2. Click **Add Price X Line Alert**:



3. On the alert window, type a name for the alert.
4. Right-click the **Preferences** box if you want to change preferences, including the recalculation setting.
5. Right-click the **Actions** box, and select **Set Actions**.
6. On the **Sound** tab, choose the sound you want played when the alert is triggered.
7. On the **Display** tab, select the windows you want opened when the alert is triggered.
8. On the **Email** tab, choose whether you want to send an e-mail when the alert is triggered.
9. Make sure the alert is turned on.

You can open a chart, Time & Sales window, or order window by right-clicking the **Line** box.
