


Setting a Study Alert

A study alert notifies you when the study output crosses the above or below values set.

1. Right-click the **Study Output** box.
2. Click **Add Study**.
3. On the **Edit Study Alert** window, select a study from the list.
4. Click the **Setup** button to change study parameters.
5. Type the symbol in the **Issue** box.
6. Click **OK**. The **Study Output** box will contain the study, symbol, and preferences.
7. Right-click the **Preferences** box if you want to change preferences, including the recalculation setting.
8. Enter an **Above** or **Below** price. You can also use default values.
9. Right click the **Actions** box.
10. On the **Sound** tab, choose the sound you want played when the alert is triggered.
11. On the **Display** tab, select the windows you want opened when the alert is triggered.
12. On the **Email** tab, choose whether you want to send an e-mail when the alert is triggered.
13. Make sure the alert is turned on.
