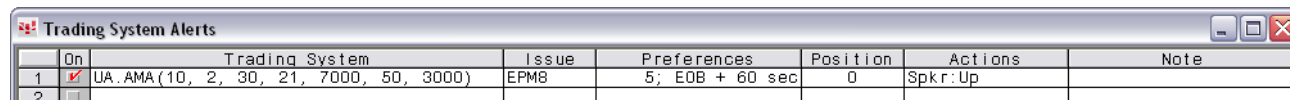


Setting a Trading System Alert

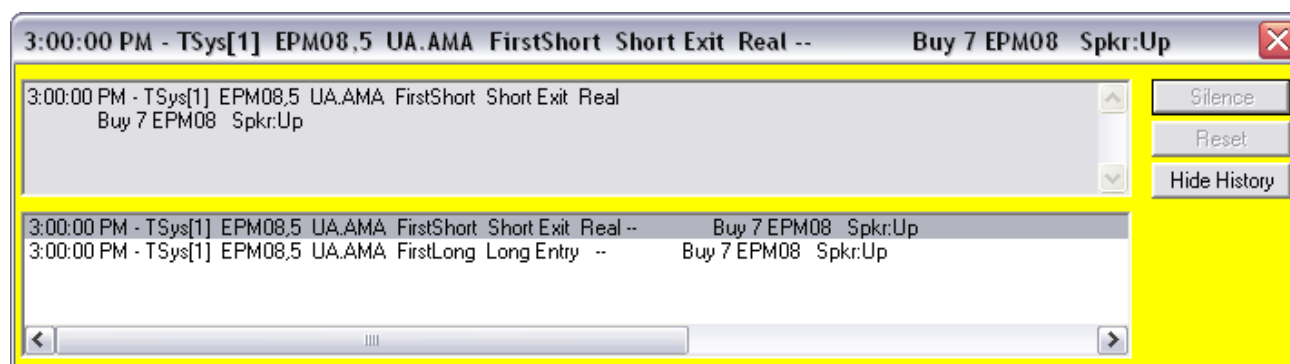
A trading system alert notifies you when your trading system indicates that a trade should be made.

1. Click the **Trading System** box. Notice that an arrow appears on the right.
2. Click the arrow and then click a trading system from the list.
3. Type a symbol in the **Issue** box. The **Trading System** box will include the parameters that are set for that trading system.
4. Right-click the **Preferences** box if you want to change preferences, including the recalculation setting.

Once the alert is triggered, it will look something like this:



To silence the alert, click the **Silence** button.

To reset the alert, click the **Reset** button.

To show all past alerts of this type, click the **Show History** button.
