- Auto Trading: Route orders from your application to the CQG Gateway. Manage orders, track executions, positions, and account statistics.

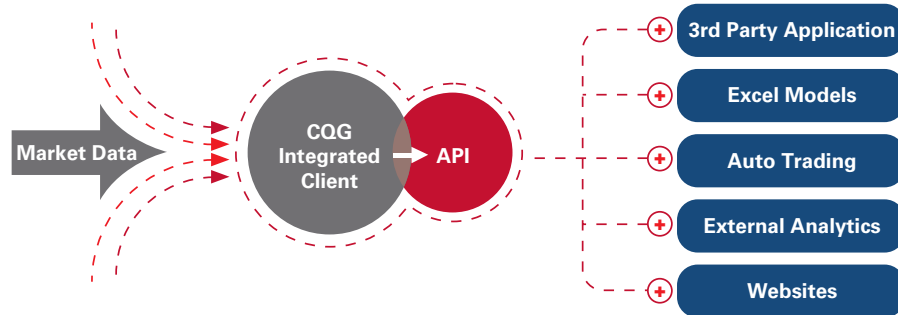
- External Analytics: CQG's API is well suited for traders developing and using black-box, program, and algorithmic trading. Access meta-data market information maintained by CQG.
