Quick Tip

CQG allows you to set sound actions for alerts once a trading condition has been met.

To set sound actions for a CQG Alert:

1. Right-click the **Above Actions** or **Below Actions** cell on the alert window.
2. Click **Set Actions**.
3. Select the **Sound** tab.
4. Select the sound you wish to have played when the alert is triggered.

You can select the **Stop sounding after check box** and enter a number of seconds the sound plays. The maximum is 300 seconds.

- Microsoft® Windows® Server 2000 Standard Edition with service packs and critical security updates.

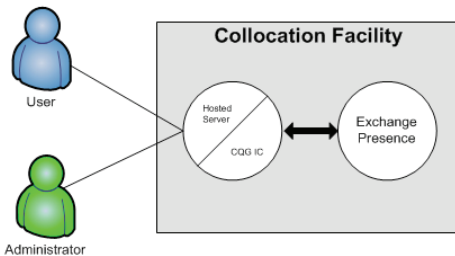
- McAfee VirusScan® Enterprise edition. An exclusion directory is available in case there are hosted files that should not be scanned.

The calendar and intercommodity spread (ICS) contracts on CQG are:

- Z3NS1: Three-year US Treasury notes calendar spread 1
- TYT – TYT: Two-year to three-year ICS
- TOF – TOF: Three-year to five-year ICS
- TUN – TUN: Three-year to ten-year ICS
- TOB – TOB: Three-year to thirty-year ICS
