Now, Help Us Understand What's Important

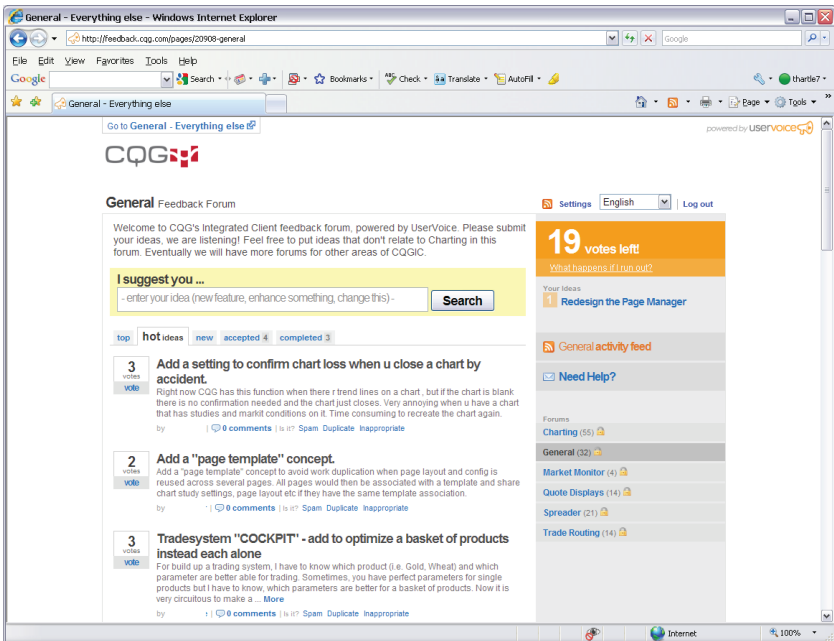

Soybean Crush spreads lagged ZME and ZLE legs:

- SOMI01Z0
